TAKE ADVANTAGE OF ENERGY OPTIMIZATION REBATES

PIE&G's Energy Optimization Program offers rebates on certain equipment as follows:

Energy Efficient Upgrade	Energy Optimization Rebate
Electronically commutated motor (ECM)	\$150
Electric Heat Pump Water Heater (2.0 efficiency factor) Must replace existing electric water heater.	\$100
Programmable Thermostat	\$20
Pipe Wrap Insulation for electric water heater	\$4
