UTILITY FLAGS

When a homeowner or company contacts the Miss Dig system, utility companies must mark with flags the location of their underground utilities within 3 days of the request. This is a free service. These flags should remain in place in the ground for 3 weeks. Removing them prior to that time could result in damage to property or cause injury.
