# Reminder: 2025 Ice Storm Recovery & Investigation Ongoing

Please do not remove broken poles, damaged transformers, or any other electric or fiber infrastructure debris. These materials are part of an active storm recovery and investigation process.

PIE&G crews are working to document and dispose of all storm-related infrastructure in full compliance with government regulations. Your cooperation is essential to ensure the safety and accuracy of this important work.

## **Gas Line Safety Tips**

To ensure safety around our natural gas lines, here are some vital reminders:

- Gas Leak Emergency: In case of a gas leak, call our dedicated hotline at 800-655-8565, available 24/7.
   Please note that this number is exclusively for gas leak reports. For other inquiries, contact us during regular business hours.
- Immediate Danger: If you encounter a broken or open gas line with a gas release, call 911 immediately.
- Pipeline Markers: Underground gas pipelines are marked periodically with yellow markers. Remember, these markers may not indicate the exact location or direction of the lines. Before any digging, dial 811 (MISS DIG) for free utility marking within three business days. Removing or damaging pipeline markers is illegal and carries penalties.
- Pipeline Integrity: PIE&G takes regular measures
  to maintain the integrity of our natural gas pipeline
  system. This includes inspections, corrosion
  control, leak surveys, and pipeline replacements
  when necessary. Our team is trained to monitor and
  respond swiftly to gas emergencies, ensuring your
  safety.

## 2025 Ice Storm Recovery Charge

At their recent member regulation meeting on June 24, the board of directors approved a \$20 monthly 2025 ice storm recovery charge. This charge will be implemented on electric bills, effective September 1, 2025. The unprecedented ice storm in March caused catastrophic damage to PIE&G infrastructure, costing more than \$100 million in repairs. These funds will be necessary to cover past and future expenses, along with unexpected loan interest, while we work to secure government disaster relief funding.

We understand this is a burden, and we appreciate your understanding of the significant costs and challenges this natural disaster has caused our membership and community.
