WINTER PROTECTION PLAN: KEEP WARM, STAY PROTECTED!

Stay Cozy This Winter with Our Winter Protection Plan (WPP)!

Designed to protect seniors and low-income members, the WPP prevents service shut-offs and high utility bill payments from November 1 to March 31.

Participation in WPP does not relieve customers from the responsibility of paying for their electric and natural gas usage but can prevent shut-off during winter months.

Members are eligible to apply for WPP with PIE&G if they meet any of the following requirements:

- Age 65 or older, or
- · Receive Medicaid, or
- · Receive Food Assistance, or
- Have a household income at or below 150% of the poverty level.

Low-Income Members Will Maintain Service from Nov 1 through March 31, as long as you:

- Contact PIE&G to provide proof of eligibility and sign an agreement.
- Pay at least 7% of your estimated annual bill each month, and
- Make equal monthly payments on any past-due bills between the date you apply and the start of your next heating season.

Senior Citizens (65 or older) Members Will Maintain Service from Nov 1 through March 31, as long as you:

- Contact PIE&G and sign an agreement.
- Seniors are encouraged to pay what they can over the winter to avoid large, unmanageable bills and shut off once the protection period ends.
- At the end of the protection period, contact PIE&G to make payment arrangements for unpaid balances prior to the next heating season.

NEW INTERNET PACKAGES START THIS MONTH!

Starting October 1st, we will be offering additional internet package options tailored to meet your needs. As we continuously strive to meet our members' needs with additional packages, we've also updated our current pricing to better align with market conditions.

Check out the new pricing and packages, effective from October 1, 2023:

- 100 MB: \$64.95 per month
- 250 MB: \$79.95 per month
- 500 MB: \$89.95 per month
- 1 GIG: \$99.95 per month

Capital credits are your contributions to our cooperative's growth and development. They're retired and refunded when our board of directors is confident it won't harm our financial stability. Until then, these allocated, unretired margins serve as your way of directly supporting our operations, enabling us to fund essential projects, expand our services, and reduce borrowing and interest expenses.

Initially, we planned to retire \$817,000.00 in Capital Credits for 2023. However, our board of directors has decided to maintain these credits within the cooperative. Why, you ask? It's all about securing our financial foundation, especially

in light of our recent investments. This decision ensures we can continue to grow and deliver top-notch services without compromise.

Your commitment and support empower us to thrive as a cooperative, ensuring a bright and prosperous future for all of us.
